- Welcome, Introductions & Minutes: Minutes approved
- Teachers' Report (Heidi, Katie and Shane)
 - Orchestra has its final concert of the year coming up June 11, currently holding auditions for fall for Symphony. Will have a Chamber Orchestra class during 0 hour next fall. It will be a strings only advanced class, must audition and not open to 9th graders Drama is having a fundraiser Cabaret on May 10th and will be a tribute to Bob Fosse's work. It is a student run production. May auction off a walk on roll in a musical and will announce next year's productions. Chicago is coming up for end of this month and beginning of June. Trip to Ashland went great. 38 students made the trip
 - o Shane: Band will be marching on the 17th of May in the Ballard Syttenden Mai Parade. On Saturday the 18th the Band will head to Victoria for the Victoria Day parade and festivities. Will return on Monday the 20th. Bands will have their final concert June 12th and will also perform at Graduation
- Treasurer's Report (Dophie)
 - Profit/Loss Statement Does not reflect April's activity as the April statement has not arrived. More donation money has come in as well as \$500 in matching funds. The Showcase costs were less than expected. Deficit is not as large as it was thought to be last month.
 - 2018/19 Expense Discussion; The Board and teachers reviewed what expenses are still needed for the remainder of the year. Uniforms were not purchased this year so the \$2000 for that item was not utilized. We may need a sound equipment for the musical. Scholarship funds will also be needed for Ashland and Victoria trip.
