- Welcome, Introductions & Minutes: Minutes approved.
- 2019/20 Budget
 - o Review: Dophie absent Jason distributed draft budget for review.
 - Amendments: Decrease 10 Minute Give by \$500; add Brown Bear as income and an expense; add mailing supplies in IPAB Mngmt costs; increase Alliance Costs to \$2,500; Student Showcase donations of \$20k is a stretch but we are committed to it.
 - o Deanna asked if we can become an Amazon.smile recipient. Judy will check with the Alliance for Education representative.
 - Approval: draft budget approved with amendments.
- Teachers' Report (Heidi, Katie, Shane)
 - o Katie (absent reported in by text): conflict with Fall Choir concert date; new date will likely be Nov 14.
 - Deanna reminded all to send concerts/fieldtrips/competition dates to Deanna and Rachel and Debbie so to be included on our communications.
 - Shane: Orchestra, Wind Ensemble and Jazz I are going well; Band will need more uniforms; Drumline may need to buy a
 couple of drums; New Coach from SPU for Jazz II is great; missing one trombone in Jazz II.
 - o Heidi (absent) no report
- Fundraising Report (Mark)
 - o Direct Ask Update: letters went out; we're currently getting something in front of families weekly; deadline for the Direct Ask is October 20; Mark will make proposed edits to letter for Deanna to post; Jason would like completed by this Friday.
 - Mark suggested we have next year's Direct Ask letters printed and ready to mail at the end of this school year to help next year's Board.
 - Brown Bear Car Wash Fundraiser: Shane it's an ASB fundraiser that IPAB sponsors and an expense to IPAB of around \$840; discussion held about moving in budget to Trip Scholarship Fund to recoup costs; Shane has ordered 500 tickets, Mark suggested IPAB members sell a portion of the tickets to offset costs.
 - Pianos: Mark obtained one piano of the three needed and feels optimistic we can find another really good one; will likely receive one from the Evergreen School.
- Volunteer Needs (Rachel)
 - November Concerts: Rachel will work on Sign Up Genius for concerts: Orchestra (11/5), Band (11/13), and Choir (tbd 11/14?).
 - Volunteers: Shane needs 8 chaperones for October Tumwater fieldtrip; Football game nights needs extra parents to help get band supplies down to the field.
 - o Shane suggested we hold Lantern Brewery fundraiser event in early May 2020 and use to recruit new Board members.

 - VP Position: Judy Nelson, volunteered to be the IPAB VP and FOI Liaison; Board nominated and approved Judy as the VP.
